2012 REFUSE & RECYCLING COLLECTION SCHEDULE

HOLIDAYS: The following six holidays usually affect the collection schedule.

These are the only holidays which will potentially alter the curbside pickup schedule. Following are the six holidays in 2012:

- 1. New Year's Day, Sunday, January 1st (curbside not affected)**
- 2. Memorial Day, Monday, May 28th**
- 3. Independence Day, Wednesday, July 4th**
- 4. Labor Day, Monday, September 3rd**
- 5. Thanksgiving Day, Thursday, November 22nd**
- 6. Christmas Day, Tuesday, December 25th**

When a holiday falls on a collection day, there is no service that day, and the week's schedule is moved to the following day. For example, Memorial Day in 2012 falls on Monday, May 28th, so Monday's route will be picked up on Tuesday, May 29th. Each route will be pushed forward one day following the holiday, with Friday's pickup occurring on a Saturday.

GENERAL REGULATIONS

Please check your route and save this schedule. Schedules may be obtained at all municipal buildings, and online at www.southhadleyma.gov.

- Household refuse and recycling collections will take place every other week (26 times per year).
- The contractor is Allied Waste Services, a division of Republic Services (413) 557-6700.
- The South Hadley Department of Public Works can be contacted at (413) 538-5033 (8 am to 4 pm), vblanchardsmith@southhadleyma.gov, or www.southhadley.org.

GREEN BAGS: Household trash must be in a Town approved Green Bag and the green bag placed at the curb either alone **or** in a refuse container. The refuse container must have two handles and be no larger than thirty-five (35) gallons in size. Weight of the large bags must be no more than forty (40) pounds. Small bag weight limit is twenty (20) pounds. It is the residents' responsibility to keep refuse contained, i.e. from being scattered by animals or the wind. Green Bags must be securely tied. Green Bags may be purchased at the following locations:

PICKUPS & CALL BACKS: Pickups start at 7:00 am daily. Your refuse and recycling must be at the curb by 7:00 am. Day of pickup is certain; time of pickup may vary. **CALL BACKS ONLY IF CONTRACTOR MISSED YOUR HOUSE.**

PLACEMENT OF GREEN BAGS & RECYCLING CONTAINERS: Place on tree belt or curbside; **MUST BE ACCESSIBLE BY HAULER.** Please place recyclable materials at least two feet (2') away from trash, space permitting.

Recycling materials must be placed at curbside in Town provided green bins. You may use other containers **only** if they are marked with Town provided stickers as follows: Green for paper/cardboard, and Orange for mixed containers (plastic, metal and glass). Stickers may be obtained at the DPW. Brown paper bags may also be used for paper. **NO PLASTIC BAGS.** Cardboard must be flattened and less than 2 feet in any dimension.

DEMOLITION MATERIAL: No construction or demolition materials (sheetrock, brick, concrete, wood, plaster, or shingles) will be picked up or accepted at the curb. They may be brought to the Recycling Center instead. A charge of \$.03/lb applies.

SEASONAL PICKUPS:

YARD WASTE and BRUSH: During the fall and spring there will be a scheduled pickup for brush, yard, and leaf waste. Brush must be tied in bundles of not more than four foot (4') lengths. Leaves and trimmings must be placed into large paper sacks or open top containers. Do Not Use Plastic Bags; they will not be accepted. Yard waste pickup schedules will be announced in local papers and cable TV, and usually occur in May and November.

CHRISTMAS TREES: Christmas trees are collected for two weeks in January, scheduling is weather dependent. Trees must be completely free of metal and ornaments; no plastic bags. Residents are also encouraged to bring trees and yard waste to the compost area, which is open every Wednesday and Saturday from 8 am to 3 pm.

NON-PICKUP ITEMS: The following items will not be picked up at the curb: bulky waste, mattresses, propane tanks, construction waste, batteries, tree stumps, refrigerators, stoves, sinks, other white goods, gasoline, oil, dead animals, tires, computers, TVs, stereos, furniture, paints, pesticides, solvents, products containing mercury, sharps, or any waste material classified as hazardous. Residents may bring Non-Pickup items to the center; fees apply.

RECYCLING CENTER: The Recycling Center is open to all residents WEDNESDAYS and SATURDAYS from 8 am to 3 pm and is located at 10 Industrial Drive. **Vehicle license plates** must be registered with the Gate Attendant in order to enter the recycling center and compost area.

Waste motor oil, waste cooking oils & grease, anti-freeze, scrap metal, fluorescent bulbs and ballasts, mercury bearing devices, household batteries (including rechargeable, button, alkaline and lithium), cell phones, *acceptable* items for Swap Shop, yard and leaf waste, used clothing and books are all accepted free of charge at the Recycling Center and Compost Area. **PLEASE NOTE: THE RECYCLING CENTER ACCEPTS CHECKS ONLY**

SHARPS PROGRAM: South Hadley has a free medical sharps program for residents to collect medical sharps such as used needles, lancets, etc. Special red sharps containers are available from the DPW Monday through Friday from 8 am to 4 pm, at the recycling center on Saturdays from 8 am to 3 pm, and at the Council on Aging (drop-off at the COA is on Thursdays only from 1-3 pm). Filled containers may be returned and exchanged for an empty container.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION EVENTS: Collections will be held at the DPW this year on Saturday, May 5th and Saturday, October 20th. Pre-registration is required and begins one month before the collection date; 538-5033 or vblanchardsmith@southhadleyma.gov.

UNWANTED MEDICATIONS: Should not be disposed of in the trash or down the drain/toilet. Please bring them to the Police Department, which accepts unwanted medications 24 hours a day. Medications which are not accepted at the Police Department may be brought to the household hazardous waste collections.

PAPER SHREDDING: Two 'Bring Three, Shred for Free' events will be held this year, on May 19th and October 6th. No registration required, donation of three items for food pantry is requested.
