Fenway Park Trips 2012

The South Hadley Recreation Department will offer three bus trips to Fenway Park the 2012 season. Tickets are sold on a first come, first paid basis and they go on sale Tuesday, February 7, 2012 for South Hadley residents and Wednesday, February 8th for non-residents. The cost for each trip is \$85 for residents and \$90 for non-residents. Checks should be made payable to the *South Hadley Recreation Dept.*

Saturday, May 26: Boston Red Sox vs. Tampa Bay Rays

- Game time is 7:15pm.
- Seats: Right field box section #90.

Monday, June 25: Boston Red Sox vs. Toronto Blue Jays

- Game time is 7:10pm.
- Seats: Right field box section #91.

Friday, August 3: Boston Red Sox vs. Minnesota Twins

- Game time is 7:10pm.
- Seats: Right field box section #92.



Bus Information:

- The bus will leave the parking lot at South Hadley High School at 3:30pm. It should arrive at 3:10pm to begin seating.
- Food and drink are allowed on the bus provided you cleanup and are respectful of others.
- There is a restroom on this King Ward bus.

The Recreation Department may limit the amount of tickets a group can purchase or the amount of games an individual can purchase based on ticket demand.

Bus Trip Policies

1. Tickets are provided on a first come, first paid basis. The Recreation Director will set the release date for all tickets/events and may limit the quantity/amount of games an individual can purchase.

2. Fees

1. Deposits (50%) may be accepted for any trip: however the full balance must be paid 30 days prior to the trip.
2. Non-resident fees will be charged at the discretion of the director. They cannot exceed \$10 per any trip under \$100 and \$20 for any other trip per participant.

3. Cancellation Policy

- a) The Recreation Department may cancel the trip within seven days of the trip due to limited enrollment. Any trip may be cancelled at any time due to weather, natural disaster, etc....
- b) Any registrant may request a full refund 21 days prior to the trip.
- c) Any registrant requesting a full refund within 21 days of the trip will only receive a refund if they can be replaced by people on a waiting list or other interested parties. If they cannot be replaced, they will not receive a refund and are responsible for their tickets.

4. Each registrant with more than one person attending the trip must provide a group leader who is responsible for their group. Each group leader must provide a list of attendees when they register for the trip.

5. All participants must act appropriately when they are on a Recreation Department sponsored trip. Any person that violates this policy will be barred from attending any future events. Inappropriate behavior includes but is not limited to:

1. Swearing, offensive remarks, etc...
2. Fighting
3. Possession of narcotics
4. Smoking on the bus
5. Alcohol abuse and disruptive behavior.
