#### Community Input

LCCs are encouraged to conduct a Community Input Survey that asks their community what arts and culture programs they'd like to see funded. This input should then be used to inform the LCC's funding priorities and guidelines for the next grant cycle. LCCs should meet and reach a quorum to approve their funding priorities and guidelines. Once approved, an LCC member must input them into the online [grants management system](#), so that information displays for applicants on the [LCC's profile](#) on Mass Cultural Council's website.

LCCs should conduct surveys and post priorities and guidelines between now and Aug. 31 so that applicants know what will be prioritized before applying. LCCs may not edit priorities and guidelines once the application period opens on Sept. 1.
