Public Hearing Notice

The Ware Community Development Advisory Committee will conduct a public hearing regarding its proposed regional Community Development Block Grant- COVID19 application to the Massachusetts Community Development Block Grant Program. The meeting will be held at **6:30pm on Wednesday, June 3rd, 2020.**

The grant application will likely seek funds for Domestic Violence Victim Safety Enhancement Program and a Senior Outreach Service Program. The public hearing will offer residents of the participating towns the opportunity to comment on the proposed projects. Participating towns included in the application are: Agawam, Belchertown, Blandford, Brimfield, Chester, Easthampton, Granby, Granville, Hadley, Hatfield, Holland, Huntington, Middlefield, Monson, Montgomery, Russell, South Hadley, Southampton, Southwick, Wales, Westhampton, Hardwick, and Warren. If awarded, the Town of Ware (as lead community) will be responsible for administration of the grant program, with assistance from the Pioneer Valley Planning Commission.
