There are 61 New Confirmed COVID-19 Cases this week, up from last week's 44 figure.

Titus Pond - The high school Advanced Placement Environmental class assisted in the installation of monitoring equipment that will log the temperature, ph, and depth of water at Titus Pond. This monitoring equipment was funded by the FY 22 Municipal Vulnerability Preparedness action grant. It is designed to stay for 5 years which allow the Town and the AP class to track changes to the water system over time. As the Town does continued work on improving the Butter Brook watershed, this data will help us understand the water system in more detail.
