There are 55 New Confirmed COVID-19 Cases this week, down from last week's 61 figure.

The Mass Dept of Public Health issued a clinical advisory to local boards of health after a Mass resident tested positive for monkeypox after returning from Canada. The symptoms of monkeypox are similar to but milder than the symptoms of smallpox.
