PUBLIC HEALTH NEWS

There are 39 New Confirmed COVID-19 Cases this week, down from last week’s 43 figure.

The state’s Department of Public Health is extending its support for covering Wastewater sampling of COVID-19 through the end of June. The Town continues to collect samples several times a week and to post that data to the website at

The data has shown fairly consistent levels over the last two weeks after a big spike in mid-May.

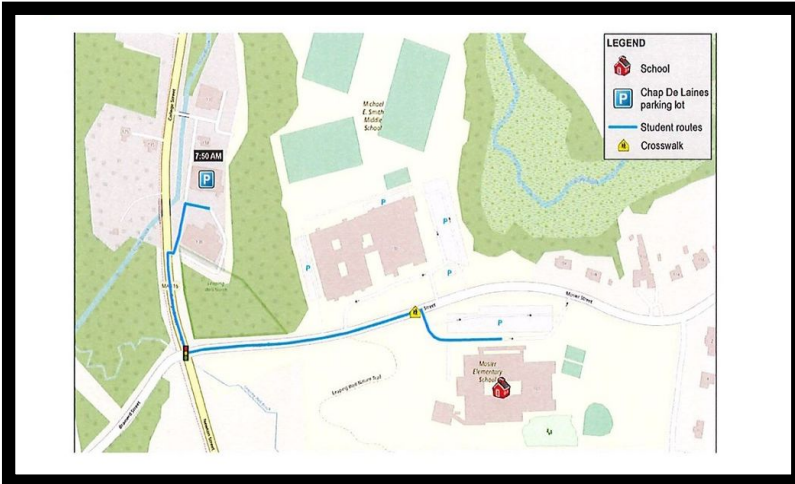
High School Graduation

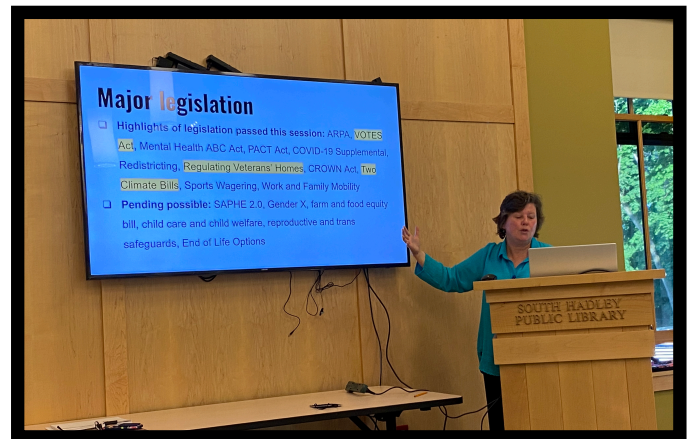
