The State announced mid-year budget cuts this week due to revenue shortfalls. The bulk of the cuts will be to MassHealth fee-for-service payments, transitional aid and a state supplement to Social Security income. This amounts to \$375 million towards the \$1b shortfall.

The full Selectboard, School Committee and Appropriations Committee will meet at the regular scheduled Feb 6 Selectboard Meeting.

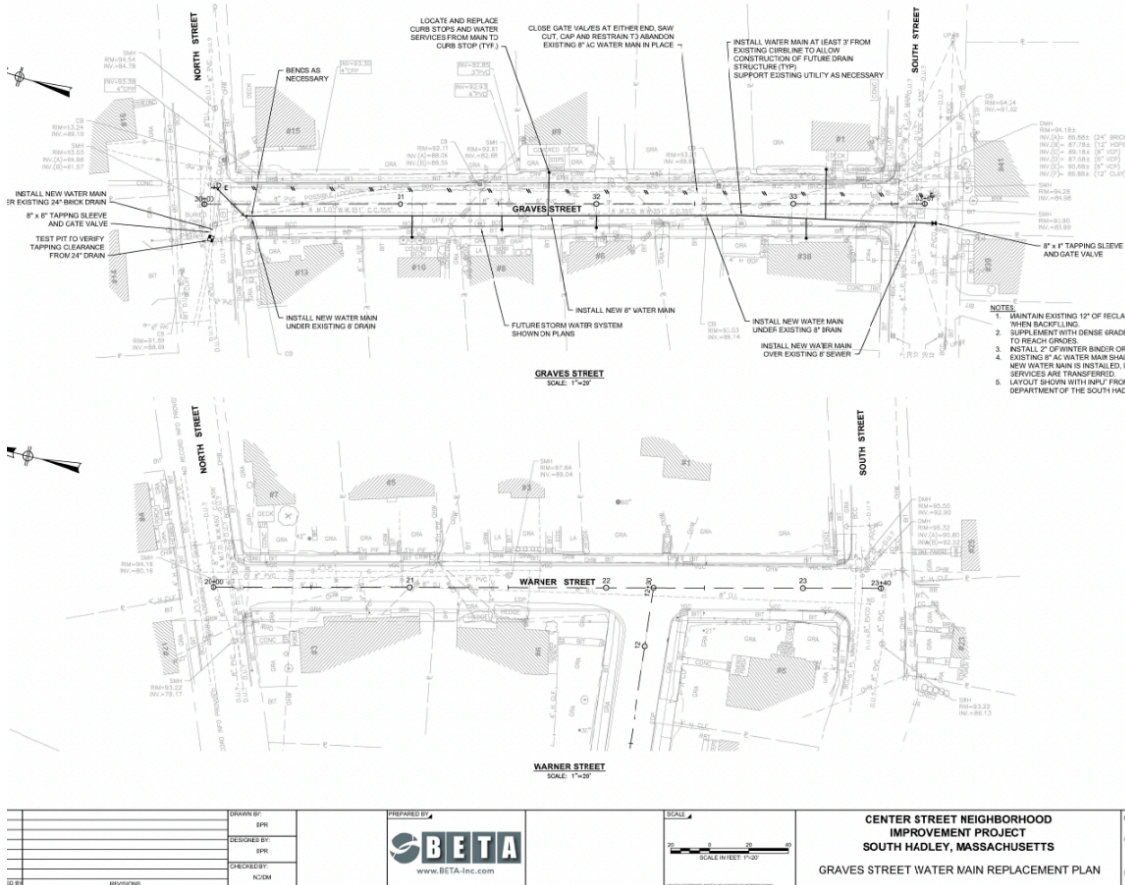

Income survey of the Center Street Neighborhood (Warner, Graves, and Center)

The Town is working with the Pioneer Valley Planning Commission to make infrastructure improvements, which may involve new water mains, improved storm

water drainage, sewer repairs, and street and sidewalk improvements. The design plans are pictured above.

One of the first steps in getting these types of projects started is to obtain general income and household information from residents who live in the service area being considered for improvements. PVPC will survey the area to collect this information and determine funding eligibility in accordance with the Massachusetts Executive Office of Housing and Livable Communities CDBG program regulations solely to determine eligibility for future grant funding. Individual survey responses are confidential information and will not be shared and are not subject to public review. Surveys will be sent to the project neighborhood households.
