FROM THE SOUTH HADLEY POLICE DEPARTMENT: After lots of research, Det. Romanovicz and Sgt. O'Connor were able to determine that the South Hadley Police Department was officially funded as part of the town's annual budget on March 16, 1874 at the town meeting. 2024 marks the 150th anniversary of the police department's creation and service to the town.

In celebration of this big anniversary, officers will be allowed to wear this special 150th anniversary badge as part of their uniform. The badge takes influences from badges that were worn in the early years of the Police Department, when officers were primarily on walking beats and used "call boxes" to communicate with headquarters. Watch for future events to celebrate the 150th anniversary.
