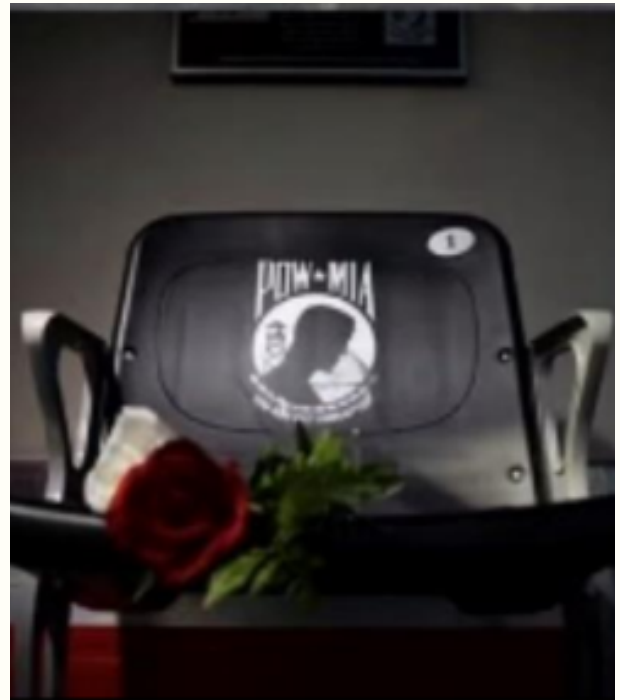

The headstone dedication ceremony for WWII British paratrooper Hugh Adamson was held at Evergreen Cemetary on Thursday. He saw action during WWII in North Africa, Sicily and Italy, and was at the Bridge in Arnhem. He was twice a prisoner of war.

The Veterans Breakfast was held at the Senior Center on Friday. Thank you to our director of Veterans Services Chris Plotniak, the Senior Center staff and the High school music and culinary programs.



The American Legion spearheaded the project to place a POW/MIA chair at the High School sports field as a permanent symbol of remembrance of our missing and teach our youth. Eight South Hadley heroes were lost during WWII.
