GEOHERMAL PROJECT



Mt. Holyoke College held a community meeting to present updates for the \$175 million geothermal project that will reduce carbon emission by 80% by 2030 and bring the college closer to being carbon neutral by 2037. Phase I (pictured above) involved laying pipes throughout the core campus. The next major phase is the installation of 240 bores that will be 6 inches wide by 600 feet deep under the existing rugby field next Summer/Fall.
