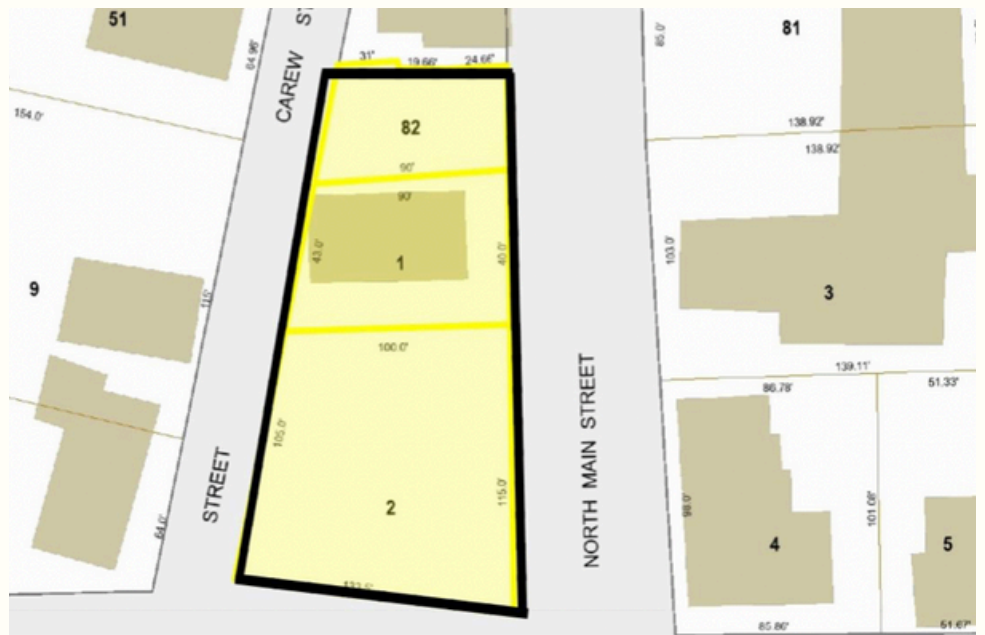

## ELEMENTARY SCHOOL PROJECT PROGRESS

The town is advertising for an Owner's Project Manager to represent the town during the feasibility study and schematic design phases of the contract, construction, and final closeout of the Proposed Project. The estimated total project costs of an approved Proposed Project may range from \$80 million to \$120 million depending upon the solution agreed upon by the Owner and the MSBA and ultimately approved by a vote of the MSBA Board of Directors. A voluntary informational session and walk-thru was held at the school on Friday.



**School and Town administration along with Building Committee Chair Diane Mulvaney and School Committee Chair Eric Friesner lead the tour and answer questions.**

The state just announced that they will be seeking applications from municipalities to apply for EV chargers (award 3 max in 15 towns) and EV charging planning (award 25 towns total). South Hadley intends to apply and has signed up for the informational webinars. The application is due in February.
