## GRANT WATCH



The federal government cancelled a \$7500 grant to the library for preservation. The grant comes from the Institute of Museum and Library Services - all of its approximately 75-employee workforce have been put on paid administrative leave Monday. On Friday, the town submitted a grant for \$2.25 million for the Titus Pond wetland restoration, and also received a technical assistance grant from the state Dept. of Environmental Protection for our new trash and recycling program.
