Buttery Brook Park Groundbreaking - March 8

Construction includes adding 4 additional pickleball courts, 9 hole disc golf course, new walking trails around the park (½ mile loop), playground enhancements with the poured in place rubber, accessibility improvements, new bandshell, basketball court repaving, parking lot improvements. Funding: \$500k state grant, \$900k town funds, \$200k+ private.

District Grants

The Town was awarded \$100k from the state Community Compact IT grant to fund a joint water metering system for District 1 and 2 Water Districts. The Fire Districts were awarded over \$11k in Firefighter Safety Equipment Grant program grants and \$4400 as part of the Student Awareness of Fire Education and Senior Awareness of Fire Education programs.
