The Selectboard will be voting on the Town Meeting warrants as outlined below at their April 29 meeting via Zoom at 4:30pm. The Town Administrator will review the articles on April 30 hybrid at the Senior Center at 6pm, along with a hearing of the budget by the Appropriations Committee at the same time.

Special Town Meeting (covers FY25)

Article 1: Appropriate \$190k to cover snow and ice

Article 2: Appropriate \$1.2m for specialized school vans

Article 3: Transfer \$510k for chromebooks and trail kiosks

Annual Town Meeting (FY26)

Article 1: Hear town reports

Article 10: Appropriate \$58,070,759 for operating budget
