Dear Voter:

Our records show that you have not answered the Annual Street Listing (Census) for the Town of South Hadley as required by Mass. General Laws Chpt. 51, Sec. 4. Therefore, your name will be designated as "inactive" on the South Hadley voting list.

If you have not moved or if you have moved to a new address within South Hadley please complete and return to our office the attached postage-paid postcard. You will then be restored immediately to the "active" voter list.

If you have moved to another city or town, please complete and sign the attached postcard and return it to our office. Your name will then be removed from the South Hadley voter list. **You must register to vote in your new city or town.** You may use a mail-in form to register.

If you do not return the attached postcard your name will be removed from the voter's list if you do not vote in at least one of the next two federal elections or take other action that would reinstate you as an active voter. The South Hadley Planning Board will hold a hybrid public hearing on Monday, September 22, 2025 at 6:30 p.m. to discuss proposing articles to Town Meeting for the purpose of amending the Zoning Bylaw to provide the Town of South Hadley with a new Sign Bylaw provision which addresses the content neutrality of signs under the Reed vs Town of Gilbert case and other local issues.

MassDOT will mill, adjust all structures, upgrade ADA transitions, repave, and install new recessed traffic markings, as well as install 2 solar X-walk crossing points as part of their Municipal Pavement Program starting this month. This project will be fully funded by MassDOT, and no Town money will be needed: Old Lyman Road to state easement line near Hollywood Street.
