Moiser Elementary School Educational Visioning Overview

During the months of September and October 2025, the Mosier Elementary School Educational Visioning Group (EVG) – a group of South Hadley Public Schools leadership, administrators, teachers, parents, and community partners will participate in three virtual 2.75-hour long Educational Visioning Workshops run by Mount Vernon Group Architects and New Vista Design. Each workshop will be a collaborative session designed to inform the design of the renovated and/or new Mosier Elementary School facility as connected to the MSBA (Mass School Building Authority) Feasibility Study that has been awarded to the district. Participants will be led through a step-by-step visioning process aimed at capturing their best thinking about the school’s and district’s current and future academic goals and priorities and connecting them to best practices and possibilities in innovative elementary school facility design.



All workshops are designed to be highly participatory, engaging, and informative. The educational and architectural goals set during these workshops will have a direct and tangible impact on the design approach toward, and features of the renovated and/or new school facility. We do hope that you will consider taking part in the workshops and sharing your ideas and dreams for the Mosier Elementary School facility. Meetings will start and end on time.

WS One will take place **virtually from 6:00-8:45 PM on Tuesday, September 30, 2025, and will explore the following topics:**

- **Priority Goals** for South Hadley Public Schools (SHPS) educational programming and Mosier’s renovated and/or new facility
- **Future-Ready Teaching and Learning Practices** that are important to SHPS and Mosier both now as envisioned for the coming decades
- **Future Ready Learning Goals** that distill the group’s best thinking about SHPS’s current and future academic programming and priorities

WS Two will take place **virtually from 6:00-8:45 PM on Thursday, October 9, 2025, and will explore the following topics:**

- **Strengths, Challenges, Opportunities, and Goals (SCOG Analysis)** associated with SHPS’s and Mosier’s current educational programming as well as the District’s vision for its future
- **Architectural Design Patterns** that SHPS would like to put into practice within a renovated and/or new facility

WS Three will take place **in person from 3:00-6:00 PM on Thursday, October 23, 2025, and will explore the following topics:**

- **Guiding Principles** for the design of the renovated and/or new facility
- **Blue Sky Ideas** for the design of the renovated and/or new facility
- **Bubble Diagramming** of conceptual design ideas for the renovated or new facility
