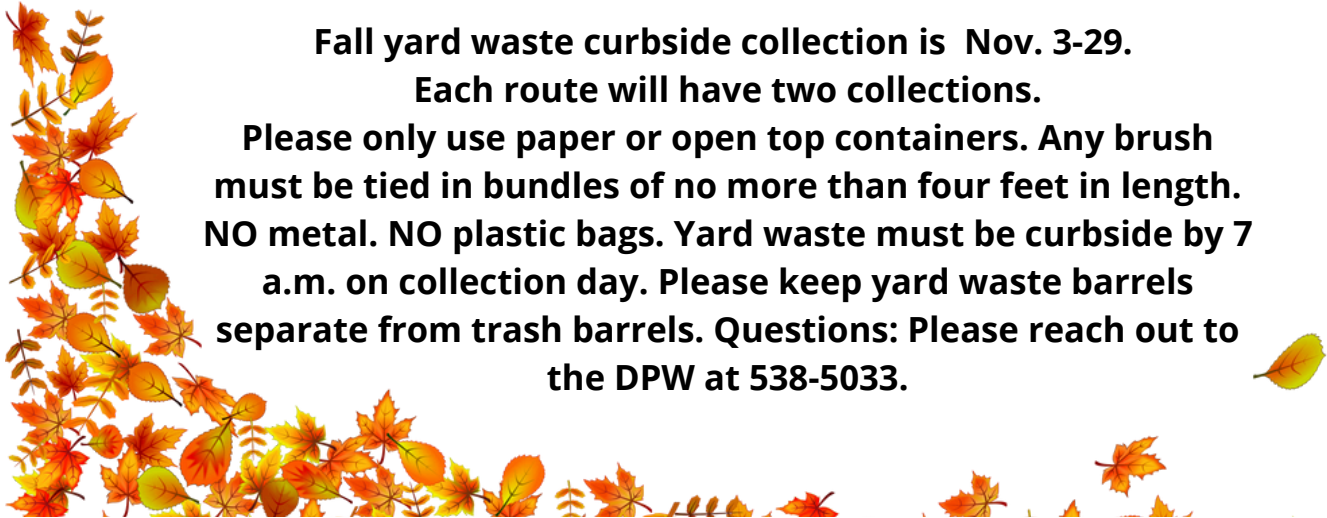

Fall yard waste curbside collection is Nov. 3-29.

Each route will have two collections.

Please only use paper or open top containers. Any brush must be tied in bundles of no more than four feet in length. NO metal. NO plastic bags. Yard waste must be curbside by 7 a.m. on collection day. Please keep yard waste barrels separate from trash barrels. Questions: Please reach out to the DPW at 538-5033.



South Hadley administration is leading an initiative to survey towns in Western Mass as part of an effort to address high health insurance costs for municipalities and public employees. The state does not collect information, track or regulate health insurance purchasing groups other than the GIC. The plan is to collect data, analyze trends and quantify the severity as part of our quest to proactively advocate for and implement solutions to cost, quality of care and access issues related to health insurance. The survey is going out this week and the team will be planning a virtual Western Mass Health Insurance forum over the winter and plan to share out the survey findings. This grassroots collaboration planning this effort also includes Southwick, Charlton, Longmeadow and East Longmeadow.



The Clover, a 60 unit 100% deed restricted affordable housing development by Wayfinders will be the first housing development in town under the provisions of Mass General Law 40R, a smart growth overlay district that encourages communities to create dense residential or mixed-use smart growth zoning districts. The closing on the property and then the 15 month estimated construction period is proceeding next week. The Selectboard appointed the Planning Director to be the town's 40R Monitoring agent this week.
