Safety Grant

The Town was awarded almost \$10k in funds to aid in helping our workers stay safe while working on the roads, in the heat, and in confined spaces. Equipment will include gas meters, fans, barricades and signage. This is part of an annual risk management grant provided by MIIA, whom the town has contracted with for general liability insurance.
