Route 33 Paving project started this week and will be completed by Thanksgiving. The project includes traffic marking milling, painting of road markings and crosswalks, and installation of solar crosswalk stanchions.

Construction started for Center/Warner/Graves. The project will involve drainage work on Grave St before December 1, pause and then will pick up again in the spring. Road and sidewalk and curbing reconstruction on center Warner and grave Street should be done during the month of June 2026.
