Sen. Oliveira and Rep. Gomez speak to residents at a Know Your Town event on Jan 30. Both are sponsoring and supporting important bills at the Legislature. The House and Senate will both take up the budget after the Governor's budget was released on Jan. 27.: <https://malegislature.gov/Budget/GovernorsBudget>. The budget is a net level funded budget with increases in aid offset by an increase in assessments (a 6k net loss). State aid is 25% of the budget (32% in FY2009).
