PUBLIC HEARING - MAIN STREET RECONSTRUCTION

South Hadley Public Library, Community Room

2 Canal Street, South Hadley, MA 01075

Thursday, April 23, 2026 at 6:00 PM

PURPOSE: The purpose of this hearing is to provide the public with the opportunity to become fully acquainted with the proposed project. All views and comments submitted in response to the hearing will be reviewed and considered to the maximum extent possible.

PROPOSAL: The proposed project consists of milling, resurfacing, full depth reconstruction, and pavement widening on Main Street in South Hadley from the Chicopee City Line to Canal Street. The work includes signal upgrades, new and reconstructed sidewalks, pedestrian curb ramps, pavement markings, and signage. Bicycle accommodations consisting of 5' bicycle lanes from Canal Street to Carew Street and a shared use path from Carew Street to the Chicopee City Line has been provided in accordance with applicable design guides. The total length of the roadway project is approximately 3,800 feet and is currently programmed for \$10.7 Million.

A secure right-of-way is necessary for this project. Acquisitions in fee and permanent or temporary easements may be required. The Town of South Hadley is responsible for acquiring all needed rights in private or public lands. MassDOT's policy concerning land acquisitions will be presented in the hearing.

Statements and exhibits intended for inclusion in the public hearing transcript must be emailed or postmarked no later than ten (10) business days (14 calendar days) after the hearing is held.

This hearing is accessible to people with disabilities.
