ABOUT THIS PLACE

The Hawkins Conservation Area is a wooded wetland bisected by a stream at the corner of Silver Street and Chapel Hill Drive. Park on the side of the road on Chapel Hill Drive. Walk down Silver Street and enter the Conservation Area by a narrow short path. It was acquired by the Conservation Commission in 1977 to be used as a bird sanctuary in memory of Professor Everett D. Hawkins of Mount Holyoke College
