

True and attested copies of the warrants were posted by Constable, Robert Lyons in five of the towns voting precincts and mailed out to town meeting members on April 25 2014. All additional local by-law requirements were met prior to hosting this meeting.

The Special Town Meeting held on Saturday May 10, 2014 was called to order at 9:05am by the Town Moderator, Edward Ryan. Quorum required sixty-one town meeting members present. It was announced ninety-two members check in. A moment of silence was recognized for all those who served the town and passed away over the last year. Awards were bestowed upon Larry Dubois, Lions Club Award, Dave Sudyka, Joe Taylor Award and Rena Myrick the Boston Post Cane Award. We Pledged Allegiance to the Flag and new town meeting members were sworn into office. Greetings were read by the Moderator. Bill Foley and Larry Dubois were appointed as tellers for the day session.

The following business was transacted:

Article 1– FY Veterans Budget Addition

Town Meeting Members voted to raise and appropriate and/or transfer from Unreserved Free Cash in the Treasury, the sum of \$20,000 or a greater of lesser sum for the purpose of funding the Veteran's Budget.

Article 2- Fibermark Demolition Appropriation

Town Meeting Members voted to raise and appropriate and/or transfer from Unreserved Free Cash in the Treasury, the sum of \$10,000 or a greater of lesser sum for the purpose of funding the Fibermark Demolition Budget.

Article 3- FY14 Snow and Ice

Town Meeting Members voted to transfer from available funds in the Treasury the sum of \$230,000, or a greater or lesser sum, to the Snow & Ice budget for the purposes of paying increased costs for snow & ice removal.

Article 4- Transfer in tree Warden Budget

Town Meeting Members voted to transfer the sum of \$7,000, or a greater or lesser sum, from the Tree Warden Other Expense budget to the Tree Warden Personal Services budget.
