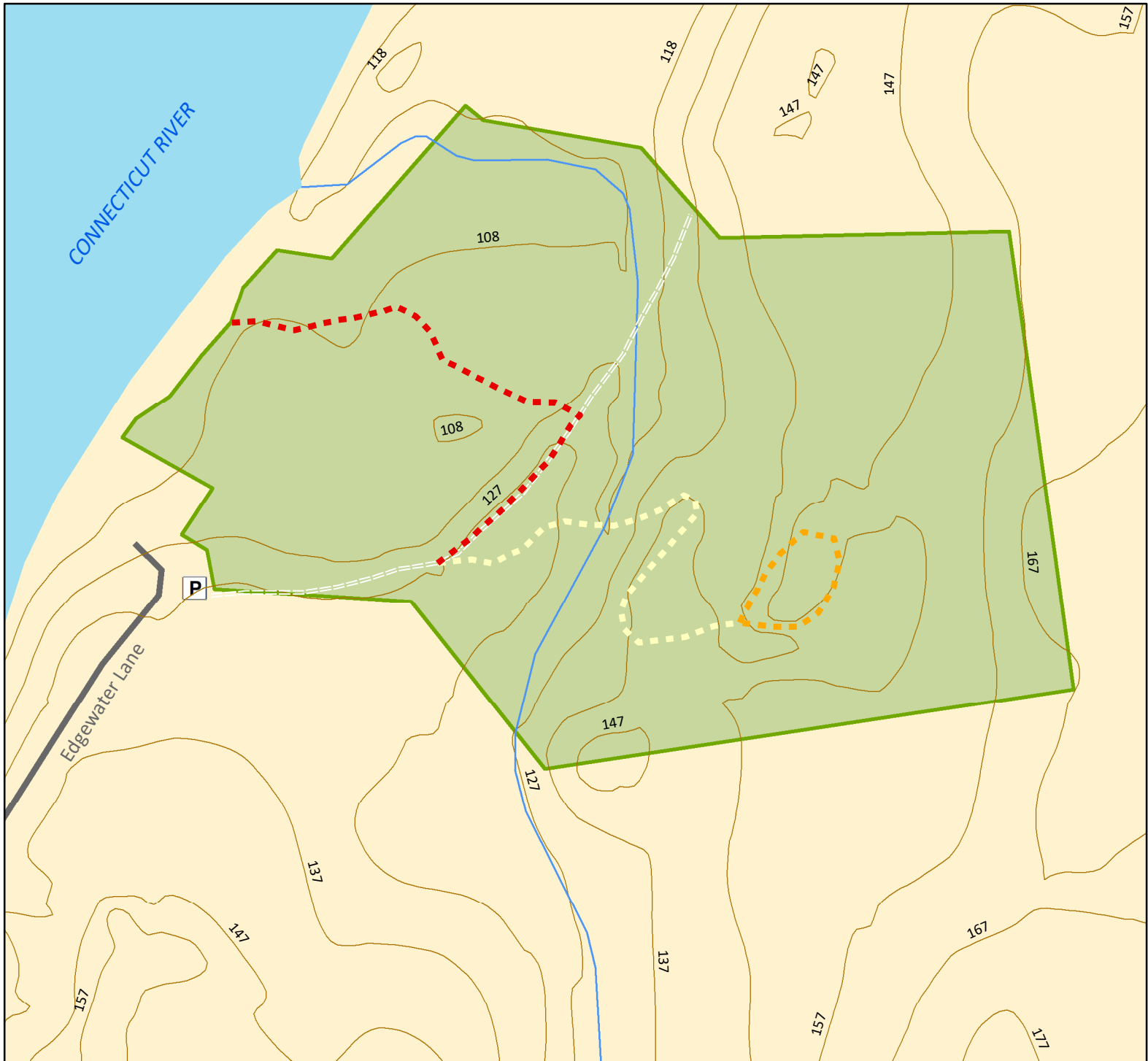


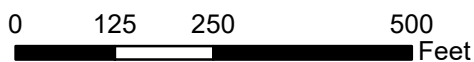
Margaret L. Bagg - Ada Pierce Wildlife Sanctuary



ABOUT THIS PLACE

This 30 acre wildlife sanctuary was donated to the Town in 1997 by Malcom Bagg, in honor of his wife Margaret L. Bagg, and his mother-in-law Ada Pierce. There are trails throughout the woodland property, with one leading to the Connecticut River, and others crossing a stream and looping a small hill. Hunting is not permitted.

From Alvord Street, take Riverlodge Road to Edgewater Lane. Parking is available on the east side of Edgewater Lane at a small trailhead.
