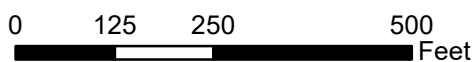




## ABOUT THIS PLACE

This 30 acre wildlife sanctuary was donated to the Town in 1997 by Malcom Bagg, in honor of his wife Margaret L. Bagg, and his mother-in-law Ada Pierce. There are trails throughout the woodland property, with one leading to the Connecticut River, and others crossing a stream and looping a small hill. Hunting is not permitted. From Alvord Street, take Riverlodge Road to Edgewater Lane. Parking is available on the east side of Edgewater Lane at a small trailhead.
